

TRANSFER OF STUDENTS BETWEEN DEPARTMENTS

Undergraduate students who want to transfer from one major to another major in the College must meet the following criteria:

Students must have a GPA of 2.00 or greater for all engineering and computer science courses taken at Wright State University.

Students must meet admission requirements to the intended major or have approval to transfer from the department of the intended major.

Students who meet the above must complete a transfer of major application and provide to the losing department. The losing department will update their records and provide the transfer application with a hardcopy of any appropriate student records through the College office to the gaining department.
