

**PHD IN ENGINEERING
2020 FIRST-YEAR ASSISTANTSHIP
INFORMATION FOR ADVISORS AND APPLICANTS**

New students entering the Ph.D. in Engineering Program in Fall 2020 are invited to apply for a 2020 First-Year Assistantship. Students will be selected based on their academic record and potential for success. Award of these assistantships is conditional on available funding.

Selection Criteria:

- Minimum Undergraduate GPA: 3.5
- Minimum Graduate GPA: 3.7
- Strong research potential
- Preference will be given to students who have completed an M.S. degree or at least
- 45 hours of graduate credit by Fall 2020
- Students application to the PhD in Engineering Program

Additional Information:

- Students must complete an application and submit the following:
 - Letter of nomination from Dissertation Advisor
 - Description of current or proposed research project (at least 100 words)
 - Résumé or Curriculum Vitae

- Faculty nomination letters should address the following issues:
 - How will the student be supported in the second year and beyond?
 - Will there be funds available so the student may travel to conferences?
- All assistantships are for one year and include tuition waiver.
- Stipend will be determined subject to available funding.
- Contracts will begin in Fall 2020 and continue for one academic year.
