## Procedure for non WSU students who want to take ME classes at WSU

- Contact Raider Connect (180 Student Union, 937-775-4000, <u>Raider.Connect@wright.edu</u>) for complete admission/registration process information. Only departmental procedure/requirements are covered here.
- Consortium (non-WSU) student registration begins April 7, 2017. (University policy allows WSU students time to register first)
- The student must meet all the WSU pre-requisites listed on the current Program Guide.
  - 1. Student sends a request and transcript via email to carla.vaughn@wright.edu.
    - a) Requests must include student name, UID number, contact information, WSU course name/number, required pre-requisite(s) and course(s) to look for on the transcript.
    - b) Transcripts (unofficial copies are acceptable for this particular purpose only) must clearly show school name, student name, course name and number and final grade.
  - 2. If the student does not have specific pre-approved equivalents of pre-requisite courses, similar courses must be evaluated. Faculty/UG advisor will determine if content is adequate to fulfill pre-requisite. Student must provide course syllabi and allow minimum 5-7 business days for processing)
  - 3. If determined eligible to take the WSU course, MME department will sign the registration form and the student shall submit it to *Raider Connect*.
  - 4. On April 7, 2017, WSU *Raider Connect* will begin registering eligible students if seats are open. If no seats are open, you will be waitlisted. If a seat opens for you, you will be notified only via your WSU email. You must act within exactly 24 hours to claim the seat.

<u>Pre-requisite courses must be **completed** with a grade of D or higher (except as noted for a few that require 'C' or higher) **before** class starts.</u>
